SUNDAY COMMUNION SERVICES

Sunday Services will be as follows

at St. Peter's Church Codsall Wood there will be an 8.30am BCP Communion service on the second and fourth Sundays of each month.

At St. Nicholas Church Codsall we will continue to have a weekly 10am Communion service.

THURSDAY MORNING COMMUNION SERVICES

At St. Peter's Church Codsall Wood we will continue to include a **10am** Communion Service on 1st, 3rd and 5th Thursdays of each month.

At St. Nicholas Church Codsall they will be on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays of each month.

BAPTISMS

If you are considering a baptism for either yourself or your children, you will be required to attend church 4 times and then approach the enquiries team on Monday evenings (**see note overleaf**) so that a suitable date can be found. Baptisms will normally be on the first Sunday of each month at 12.00 noon and 1pm.
